THE TEN ROOT CAUSES OF POVERTY



To systematically address these challenges, the Florida Prosperity Project has identified the 10 root causes of poverty:

- Job Opportunities: Lack of employment opportunities
- Education/Training: Lack of quality in education & workforce development
- Housing: Unaffordable and/or unattainable housing
- Transportation: Insufficient transportation options
- Health: Disproportionate health access and outcomes
- Food Security: Lack of consistent access to nutritionally adequate and safe foods
- Child & Family Care: Inaccessible & unaffordable childcare
- Safety: Unsafe environments
- Justice: Imbalanced outcomes in the criminal justice system
- Agency/Community Voice: Lack of recognition and access within a community
